YOUR PROGRAM

Day 1 - Departure from Genoa

Board the evening ferry from Genoa (times may vary, but this is usually around 20h30). If you arrive in Genoa with time to spare, take the opportunity to visit the city, which is full of hidden and authentic treasures. Overnight on the ferry.



Day 2 - The north

Arriving in the morning in Olbia, take the road to discover the far north of the island. Follow the coast and discover Porto Cervo, Palau and Santa Teresa di Gallura. To reach the seaside it will be necessary to make a few small detours. A trip to the Maddalena islands is a must!

Riding on a beautiful coastal road, you will reach the Castelsardo region, known for its village perched on the top of a rocky hill and the starting point of your magnificent holiday.

Overnight in a 4-star hotel in Castelsardo.

Distance: 140Km.





Day 3 - Villages and beaches

After breakfast, it's time to hit the road. Weave your way through charming Sardinian villages. Today's program takes in old churches, beautiful lakes, sea caves and much more. After a stop in Bosa to explore the citadel, get back in the saddle to end your day's ride at a superb hotel near the sea.

Overnight in a 5-star hotel in Tresnuraghes.

Distance: 100-150Km.

Day 4 - From the beaches of the west to the mining south

This day will take you alongside the beaches to a less touristy and surprisingly wild south. On the way, you will be able to explore the sight of Tharros which recalls the vestiges encountered in Greece. Discover ghost villages abandoned after the closure of mining activities. The beaches and dunes of the Costa Verde are breathtaking. In the evening, you will stop in a small town known for its history.

Overnight in a 4-star hotel.

Distance: 150km.



Day 5 - The great south



After breakfast enjoy a free day or ride a beautiful loop to discover the southern tip of Sardinia. Explore the natural park where many species of birds nest, visit a mine, a beautiful underground cave or even some superb beaches. After a hard day of sight seeing, relax in the spa.

Return to your 4-star hotel.

Distance: 160Km.



Day 6 - Towards the eastern coast

Today you will ride across the island from one side to the other. Discover many Nuraghic remains as well as beautiful villages and lakes in the interior. Ride through Sardinia's most famous village, known for its murals, and eventually reach one of the island's most popular seaside resorts. You will be staying in the heart of the resort in a beautiful hotel overlooking the harbour.

Overnight in a 4-star hotel in Cala Gonone.

Distance: 235Km.

Day 7 - The Gulf of Orosei

A day of rest in the Gulf of Orosei. Take a boat trip to the beautiful and inaccessible wild beaches of the region. Such treasure. Second night in Cala Gonone.

Day 8 - Mystic and secret Sardinia

After breakfast today's ride will take you back into the interior. Remember to keep your camera handy! The views of the Gulf are magnificent. Continue your journey through the Sardinian countryside to the village of Orgoszolo, famous for its murals. A short detour will take you to one of the most famous nuraghes in Sardinia, Romanzesu, lost in the middle of a splendid forest of cork oaks. Reach a small village overlooked by a magnificent hotel that will welcome you for the night. Don't forget to ask the owner to let you taste his wine, a real pleasure to be enjoyed with fresh homemade pasta!

Overnight in a 4-star hotel.

Distance: 140Km.

Day 9 - Returning to Olbia

Enjoy a gentle motorbike ride to Olbia for the evening ferry.

Take the opportunity to make your last purchases in town. If you are looking for a little peace and quiet, visit Golfo Aranci and one of its wild beaches.

Board the boat at the end of the afternoon. Overnight on the ferry.

Distance: 100Km.

Your arrival in Genoa marks the end of this superb trip to Sardinia. Arrivederci!
